



Job Title: Warehouse Assistant

Position Overview

Warehouse Assistant reports to the Warehouse Manager and assists in the overseeing of all logistic activities, including inventory of all equipment and materials/supplies, repairs of all equipment and vehicles, maintenance of all equipment and vehicles, property security, and storage of chemicals.

Essential Job Duties and Responsibilities

- Maintain minimum warehouse inventory of supplies and materials
- Maintain inventory control of all equipment, tools, supplies, chemicals and materials
- Maintain vehicle maintenance (including fluids, fuel, tires, etc)
- Maintain property cleanliness and security (including proper maintenance and operations of all gates, fences, doors, locks, lighting, etc)
- Order supplies and materials as needed to maintain minimum inventory, keep all vehicles stocked and have materials and supplies needed for jobs.
- Maintain Emergency Response Trailer
- Manage incoming and outgoing of all materials, supplies, chemicals and equipment (tools, etc)
- Maintain warehouse and storage areas in a safe and organized manner at all times.
- Coordinate with Job Coordinators and Estimators on materials, supplies and equipment needed for jobs in advance to stage everything the night before needing it.
- Make sure dumpster is only used for appropriate disposal
- Ensure trash is placed on curb for pick up weekly
- Maintain MSDS sheets on all products requiring them, in warehouse and in each vehicle.
- Maintain first aid kits in each vehicle and in the warehouse
- Maintain fire extinguishers

Requirements

- Minimum High School Diploma
- Computer literate with knowledge and experience with MS Outlook, MS Word, MS Excel
- Pass drug screening and criminal background check
- Clean driving record
- Ability to drive company vehicles
- Have reliable transportation
- Availability to respond to 24 hour emergencies or mitigation calls

Physical Requirements

- Ability to stand, squat, climb, bend, kneel, stoop, walk, push, pull, crouch and crawl for long periods of time
- Ability to travel up and down ladders
- Ability to lift up to 75lbs on a regular basis
- Ability to work in high places and in tight spaces
- Capable of working in fire, smoke and/or water damage environments that have potential for mold & mildew
